

Wedelia trilobata (蟛蜞菊)



Description

Wedelia trilobata (蟛蜞菊) is a very common species of vegetation used as ground cover in the landscape work in Hong Kong. As a native ground cover, it grows to about in maximum 250 mm long with stolons and dense and broad leaf.

It is an evergreen plant and blooms profusely with 2-3cm yellow flowers singly at the end of each stem. It is an aggressive creeping plant that spreads around dense stolon and leave very quickly.

Different from other hydroseeding grass species, the Wedelia trilobata (蟛蜞菊) grows to the maximum height of about 250 mm such that the regular cutting is not necessary. It is also different from the non-native species of the imported grass e.g. Bermuda, Bahia, Rye used in hydroseeding work, the native Wedelia trilobata (蟛蜞菊) does not require intensive maintenance work such as watering and fertilizing.

Advantages of Usage

1. Grows best in moist, well-drained and fertile soil.
2. Adaptable in tropical climates.
3. Excellent ground cover in warm climates.
4. Good for soil retention and erosion control.
5. Restrict the growth of weeds effectively.
6. Low maintenance is required.
7. Constant and prolific blooming gives an attractive scene.
